**ENTRIES CLOSE May 31, 2011—Horses Entered after May 31: Late Fee \$20 per horse**

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

**ENTRIES CLOSE MAY 31, 2011.** Entries postmarked later than May 31st will be charged a post entry fee of \$20 per horse. There is no post entry fee for classes entered at the show.

**Post Entries:** Will be accepted before the end of the session prior to the session in which the class will be held.

**Management** reserves the right to refuse a *Post Entry* in classes where the additional entry would make it necessary to split the class. **Management** reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class where it is deemed advisable and to reschedule any divided class. **Management** reserves the right to decline any entry and to return any entry fees before or during the show without being liable for compensation. **Management** reserves the right to divide any class which might have so many entries that all cannot be shown and judged properly at the same time or hold eliminations prior to the performance. Where eliminations are held, a person can ride or drive only one horse. If a class is divided, duplicate prizes will be awarded.

**Post Entries:** Post entries will be accepted a session prior to the session in which the class will be held.

**Scratches:** All entry and stall fees will be refunded upon request before the closing date of entries. After this date, entry fees only will be refunded upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate. Upon presentation of a veterinarian's certificate, an additional horse may be post-entered before the start of the show in place of the excused horse at regular entry fees. After the start of the show, entry fees only will be refunded upon presentation of a certificate from a veterinarian who has examined the horse while on the show grounds. Exhibitors are urged to report all scratches to the Secretary's office as early as possible.

**Sharps:** Management requests that exhibitors comply with USEF Rule GR 1210 regarding "**SHARPS.**" Failure to do so will result in a fine.

Horses shown in this division must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association, Inc., the Canadian Morgan Horse Association, or the British Morgan Horse Society, and must be entered under their full registered name and registration number, or if under one year of age be eligible for registration. Horses must be entered under the names of the owner(s) or lessee of record with AMHA, CMHA, or BMHS. **A COPY OF THE REGISTRATION PAPERS SHOWING RECORDED OWNERSHIP OR PROOF OF LEASE MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH ENTRY FORM AT THE TIME OF MAKING ENTRY.**

**Health Requirements:** The Virginia Department of Agriculture requires **all horses entering the show must have a negative Coggins certificate (e.i.a.) within the last twelve months\***, and **all out of state horses must have a current health certificate (within 10 days) available upon arrival at the show grounds. Copies of the Coggins tests and the health certificate of horses entered must be presented to the show secretary before numbers will be issued.** A copy of the Coggins test will remain on file for 1 year with the Virginia Department of Agriculture. \*Weanling(s) requires a Coggins Certificate unless accompanied by the dam when the Coggins Certificate of the dam is sufficient. Show management requests you forward a copy of your Coggins tests with entries.

**The night phone number to reach the show veterinarian is posted at the show office.**

**Definitions:**

**Maiden, Novice and Limit** classes are open to horses which have not won one/three/six first place ribbons respectively, at Regular Member Shows of this Association or the Canadian Equestrian Federation in the particular performance division in which they are shown.

**Limit Rider classes qualify for the appropriate junior exhibitor or amateur championships.**

**Amateur Classes** are open to riders/drivers of all ages. Adult exhibitors in any amateur class must have a current USEF Amateur Certification in their possession or make application in the horse show office at least one session before the class.

**Ladies Classes** shall be limited to ladies 18 years and older as of Dec. 1 of the previous year.

**Ladies and Gentlemen Classes** in all Divisions qualify for the Open as well as the Amateur Championship in that division if ridden (driven) by an Amateur in the class.

**Junior Exhibitor Classes** are open to individuals who are under 18 years of age as of December 1 of the previous year and will qualify for the respective Amateur and/or Open Championships.

**Youth Classes** are open to individuals who are under 22 years of age as of December 1 of the previous year.

**Adult Classes** are open to individuals who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the previous year.

**HORSE SHOW OFFICE:** The Horse Show Office will open Tuesday, June 21 at noon.

An agent may make entries for more than one owner, but each owner must be on a separate, signed entry blank. A \$25 office fee will be charged per owner (non refundable). A program will be included with each entry.

Entries are payable in U.S. Funds only. A \$50 fee will be charged to exhibitors who fail to pay their fees before leaving the show. A \$25 fine will be assessed to any exhibitor failing to notify the Horse Show Office of a scratch before the beginning of the session. **Returned Checks/Declined Credit Card Policy:** There will be a \$25 charge for returned checks or declined credit cards presented as payment for horse show fees. Within 5 days of receiving notification from the bank and/or credit card company, the secretary or designated show representative will send a registered letter to the person presenting the check or credit card. If payment is not received in the form of a certified check, money order or cash within 2 weeks of notification, the exhibitor will be turned into the USEF for non-payment of fees. Fines to the USEF as a result of non-negotiable funds can run as high as \$750. Multiple declines will be charged multiple fees.

**Stabling:** Stalls will be available for the duration of the shows for \$110 each. All stalls are permanent stalls, with sliding doors which cannot be removed. Stalls are metal construction with solid sides. Exhibitors are responsible for bringing their own wood for hanging tack drapes.

**Bedding:** No initial bedding will be provided. All bedding arrangements must be made through the Virginia Horse Center, Stable Office (540-464-2950). Exhibitors may bring their own bedding (with the exception of paper or sawdust). Outside vendors are prohibited from selling and/or delivering grain, straw, hay, or bedding.

**Arrival Times:** Stalls will be available for occupancy at 12 noon, Tuesday, June 21, and must be vacated by noon, Sunday, June 27. **EARLY ARRIVAL PRIOR TO JUNE 21:** horses may arrive by 1:00 P.M. Monday, June 20. Early arrivals will be billed an additional \$30 for each day/night per stall. It is recommended not to arrive between midnight and 7:00 AM. If this presents a problem, contact show manager: Kent Moeller, cell phone number 804-363-3085.

**Campers:** A charge of \$30 per night will be charged which includes: 50 Amp. Electrical Service, and water. There is no sewer hook-up but there is a dumping area at the site. All camper fees must be

paid directly to the Virginia Horse Center. Ample spaces are available, on a first come first serve basis.

**Motorized Vehicles**—Minors who do not have a valid driver’s license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver’s license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**Parking:** All vehicles must be parked in the areas designated by the Virginia Horse Center.

**Rings:** Show Arena (Anderson Coliseum) 150' × 250', other standard sized rings available. Footing is sand dirt mix.

The Show Committee reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation or damages. The Show Committee will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any rider, driver, groom or attendant, animal or equipment at the show. Nor will the Show Committee be responsible for loss or destruction of any property or equipment or damages to or by animals on exhibition at the show, grounds, or stabling area.

**Holds:** Any request for a hold must be approved by the show manager and must be received in the preceding session. Request must be made by trainer or adult owner/agent.

**Prizes:** A trophy and six ribbons will be awarded in every class except where noted. A challenge trophy is to be won three times by the same exhibitor and/or horse for permanent possession.

Readers are permitted, but it is the responsibility of the competitor to arrange for a person to read the test. Errors in reading the test will not relieve the rider from error penalties.

Scoring as follows: 50% movement; 40% conformation and 10% manners. In the event of a tie, the horse with the highest conformation score will win. If there is also a tie on the conformation score, additional tie breakers are—highest movement score followed by the judge breaking the tie. This is a scheduled class. Entries must be received by May 31, 2011 to ensure a time slot.

1. No smoking in Coliseum or Barns. This is the law.
2. **DRIVE CAREFULLY. OBEY ALL TRAFFIC SIGNS. Speed limits are strictly enforced. The use of motor vehicles in the camping area is restricted to regular roadways for entering and exiting only. Every motor vehicle operator must have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance. Golf carts, powered scooters and mopeds are permitted if operated in a safe manner (this is a Virginia state law), but *may not* be used in the Coliseum or in the interior of any of the barns.**
3. **Dogs/Pets:** All dogs/pets must have current inoculations for rabies as prescribed by state of residency. No loose dogs/pets are allowed anywhere on the premises. All dogs/pets that are not crated must be on a hand-held or tied leash. Loose dogs/pets will incur a \$100 fine. You must clean up after your dog/pet. **Coliseum:** Absolutely no dogs/pets allowed in the Coliseum *unless* they are crated. Absolutely no dogs/pets in the Mezzanine (2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Coliseum) under any circumstances. This is the law. **Grounds/Parking Areas/Barns/East Complex:** All dogs/pets must be on a hand-held or tied leash.
4. No trash or sharps in the manure pits. Sharps should be placed in red boxes in barns.
5. No lunging in posted rings. Wiley, Speed, and B Rings NEVER.
6. No overnight horses may be stabled in trailers or tied out.
7. Horses are absolutely **not** allowed to be ponied behind any moving vehicles.
8. Four-wheelers and ATV's are not allowed on the VHC grounds. Non-powered scooters, bicycles, skateboards, inline skates, and heelers (skates in shoes) are not permitted in the Coliseum or the interior of any of the barns.
9. No vehicles allowed in the barns.
10. Campers must register at Stable Office.
11. Check-In time and Check-Out time subject to show date.
12. No gray water is to be dumped on the ground. Sewage arrangements are made through the stable office.
13. Campfires are not permitted.
14. Campers must keep their sites clean and dispose of refuse in the receptacles provided. All campers will be responsible for leaving the campsite as they found it. Any damage or repairs resulting from negligence shall be the responsibility of the camper.
15. All central service buildings and other facilities in the campground are for campers' and exhibitors' use only.
16. Firearms and fireworks are not permitted.
17. No tent, camper, RV or camping equipment shall be left unattended longer than 24 hours without written permission from campground management.
18. Any loss, theft, accident or disturbance should be reported to the Virginia Horse Center Security. Lost and Found is located in the Security Office.
19. Virginia Horse Center management reserves the right to remove from the premises any camper or visitor who is in violation of these rules and regulations.
20. The Virginia Horse Center shall be held harmless against all claims, costs, losses or liability of every nature and kind asserted against or incurred by camper arising or resulting in any respect from camper's occupancy and use of premises, and/or visitor and visitor's use of premises.

EVERY CLASS offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the USEF Rule Book and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. In situations arising which are not covered specifically by USEF Rules, the following rules, or the rules specific to each show (contained in the individual sections), the decision of the Show Managers and/or Stewards shall be final. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30 NON-MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE; 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES; 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION, 10) USEF BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

*By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing the entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (The "Federation") and the local rules of the Competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the Competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the Competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise any product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocable waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State, See GR 908.4.*

**USDF Membership Benefits:** USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the *USDF Competitor & Member Guide* or the USDF Web site at [www.usdf.org](http://www.usdf.org).

**Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions:** Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership, Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF NM fee. (Note: USDF business members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF BM.) Individuals cannot compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition with a USDF Education Membership.

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

**Exceptions:**

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, Pas de Deux, Quadrille, FEI ParaEquestrian classes, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy and opportunity classes. For foreign-owned horses competing in a CDI, USDF accepts copies of the horse identification pages from an FEI passport in lieu of a USDF HID or LHR number.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

**Memberships Defined**

**Participating Membership (PM):** A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$75), 5-years (\$300), or life (\$1,500). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21<sup>st</sup> birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$60). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan<sup>®</sup>/USDF Year-End Awards, Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders' Championship Series Finals and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

**Group Membership (GM):** A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards program.

**Business Membership (BM):** A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$200) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

**Education Membership (e-Membership):** A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. This online education only membership expires 12 months after the date joined. This membership type does NOT allow an individual to compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition.

**Non-Member (NM) Identification Number:** For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$25 and a USDF NM form per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF member there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF Web site.

**Horse Identification (HID) Number:** A one-time tracking number for horses (\$25). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT be counted towards Adequan<sup>®</sup>/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes or Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders' Championship Series Finals. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$70. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

**Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR):** A horse with an LHR (\$95) is eligible for Adequan<sup>®</sup>/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders' Championship Series Finals and Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

**How to Join USDF**

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date received by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.

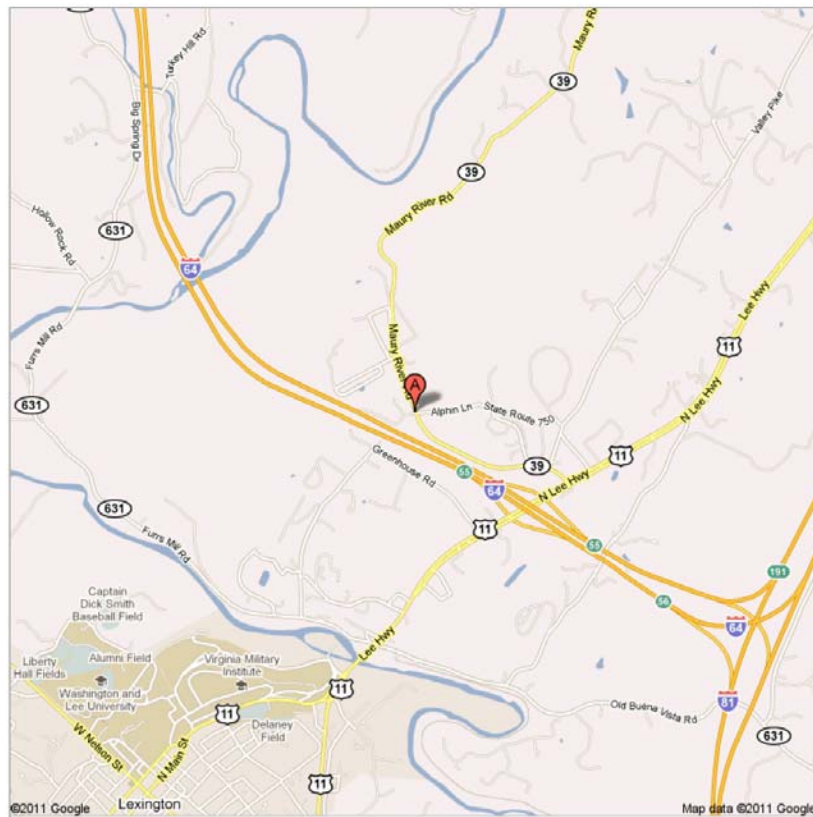
The Virginia Horse Center is located at 487 Maury River Road, on the northwest side of Lexington, Virginia.
